The Benefits of Studying in Canada ✨

Earn while you learn

Students in Canada are allowed to work up to 20 hours per week Off-Campus and an unlimited amount of hours On-Campus. So, you are privileged to EARN WHILE YOU LEARN.



Accelerate your 2-year program

You can complete your two-year program in 16 months making you eligible for a three-year post-graduate work permit (PGWP). Classes are usually 3-4 hours/day, 4-5 days/week.



Accelerate your 1-year program

You can complete your one-year full-time study in 8 months making you eligible for a one-year post-graduate work permit (PGWP). Classes are usually 3-4 hours/day, 4-5 days/week.



Affordable medical insurance

Your medical insurance is covered during your education with a minimal fee mentioned on the government website. Once you receive your work permit, after your studies, you will be eligible for free health care in Canada.



Earn interest on your first-year living expenses

When you buy a GIC (Guaranteed Investment Certificate) from eligible banks in Canada, you are earning interest in exchange for your money. This GIC money will be deposited in your bank every month so you can use this money for living expenses which may be sufficient for a year or you can save it.



Post-graduate work permit eligibility

After successfully completing the qualifying program, you could get a Post-Graduate Work Permit (PGWP) of up to 3-Years. The PGWP (Post-graduate Work Permit) can help you get additional points needed to qualify for Permanent Residence by way of gaining sufficient Canadian work experience, as applicable.

Open work permit for spouse of the student

During the period of study, the spouse of the student is eligible for an open work permit and can work full-time in one or multiple jobs.



Free education of your child(ren)

The child (ren) of the student can go to school for free up to 12th grade (if eligible).

PR eligibility for your spouse

During the period of study, if the student and/or his/her spouse gets a valid job offer from an employer who is willing to support their permanent residence, they may be eligible to apply for it. In such a case, they can become PR even before completion of studies, thus completing your studies may not be necessary to qualify for permanent residence.



IMPROVE YOUR COMPREHENSIVE RANKING SYSTEM (CRS) SCORE

Based on recent and previous Express Entry draws your CRS scores may not be competitive. One way to increase your points in Express Entry is to gain a job offer, however Canadian employers are often hesitant to offer jobs to foreign applicants overseas because the process is inconvenient, expensive and cumbersome for them. It can also be time-consuming, stressful and risky for the applicant. When you are looking for a job offer in Canada, it is also easy to fall victim to scams involving fake job opportunities. For these reasons, studying is often a better option for most people who are looking to improve their chances in express entry and it also allows you to gain world-class education that will support your professional development.



***Studying in an eligible program can allow you to increase your points in
express entry in up to four ways:***

- If the credential you are studying in Canada is higher than your previous credential or if it allows you to claim points for “Two or more certificates, diplomas, or degrees” your points in education will increase.
- You will gain extra points for Canadian education regardless of the level of study
- If you complete a program that is eligible for a Post-Graduate Work Permit after studies and you work in an eligible position for one year or more you can gain points under Canadian experience and you may be eligible to apply under Canadian Experience Class.
- If you are in an eligible program your spouse may be able to gain Canadian Work Experience under an Open Work Permit while you study that could further increase your points.

Generally, studies in Canada may improve your score by 50-100 additional points depending on various factors.

STUDENT DIRECT STREAM Vs REGULAR STREAM

	Student Direct Stream (SDS)	Regular Stream (RS)
Definition	Student Direct Stream enables students to apply for visa applications which are faster and quicker in process under this stream.	Students who do not meet the requirements of the Student Direct Stream get a chance to apply for a study visa under this Regular stream which is comparatively slower.
SDS Requirements		RS Requirements
Language Proficiency Test	Students must clear the English Proficiency test, IELTS (Academic) with an overall band of 6.5 and at least 6 in each of the four abilities viz. Listening, Reading, Writing, Speaking.	Students must meet the language requirements of their academic program or enroll in an English pathway to meet the requirements of the program. The student should include any English Tests taken for admission into the program with their Study Permit application.
Passport	Students need valid passports.	Students need valid passports.
Guaranteed Investment Certificate (GIC)	Students need to deposit CAD \$10,000 (preferably \$10,250) of GIC in any of the listed banks that offer Student GICs that meet IRCC requirements. Upon arrival in Canada, students will receive CAD \$2000+interest deposited in their bank account, and the rest of the money will be deposited instalment wise which sums up to CAD \$667 for the next 12 months. (While CAD \$10,000 is required, we suggest adding another CAD \$250 to cover any bank charges and to ensure the net amount of the GIC does not fall below CAD \$10,000, otherwise, the application may be denied, even if it is just 1 cent short).	GIC is not mandatory for Regular Stream as long as they can provide sufficient evidence that they can meet the tuition fees and living expenses for the first year.
Tuition Fee	Students need to pay the full first-year tuition fee to qualify and submit proof.	Students can provide proof they have paid their initial tuition fee deposit and demonstrate their ability to pay the balance with their financial documents.

	Faster Processing Times	Slower Processing Times
Better Consideration of Financial Ability	Since, through this stream, the tuition fees are paid upfront, and a GIC in Canadian Dollars is provided to cover their living expenses, the applicant's financial ability will not be scrutinized as heavily as in the regular stream. The proof of payment for the first year's fees and a Guaranteed Investment Certificate of CAD \$10,000 or more are significant supporting documents.	Students have to submit more financial documents that justify their financial stability. The documents may include Proof of Income such as Income Tax Returns, Form-16, J-Forms, etc. Students may also have to add other asset proofs in the form of General Provident Fund, Bank Statements, Fixed Deposits, net worth statements, financial support from a family member, loans, scholarships, and many more. The student can still choose to take out a GIC or pay their first-year fees upfront if they can for better consideration.
Processing Time	The processing time for the SDS category is usually 20 days to 1 month.	The processing time for the Regular Stream is usually 2-3 months.

Study visa applicants are required to pay the following fees / charges, when applying for a study permit in Canada to the Government / other agencies.

Study permit	\$ 150 CAD
Biometrics	\$ 85 CAD (Maximum \$ 170 CAD for more than 1 person)
Medical Exam	\$ 400 - \$ 500 CAD*
IELTS Academic	\$ 300 CAD*
Police Certificate (if applicable)	\$ 50 CAD*
College Registration Fee	\$ 100 - \$150 CAD (approximately, depending upon the program / college)
Translation Fee (if applicable)	\$ 50 - \$ 100 CAD (depending upon the nature of documents and number of pages)
Professional Fee	\$0 - \$3000 CAD (approximately, as the case may be, depending upon the complexity of the case)


